IRCP: This week the Diocese of Ogdensburg released its report detailing the outcome of the independent Reconciliation and Compensation Program or "IRCP". The IRCP is part of an ongoing effort to express contrition to those who suffered sexual abuse by diocesan clergy and to help them find healing. This report outlines the IRCP's progress, including the number of victims and accused abusers and compensation distributed. It also reviews the lessons learned in the process and summarizes our Safe Environment program and how allegations of misconduct are handled today.
